



Subject: "IMO GISIS Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Database – Recognized Organizations Authorization"

GISIS: Ship Fuel Oil Consumption

1. Mar Cir 11/2022 on Fuel Consumption Data and Recording – MARPOL Annex VI

1.1. The International Ships Registry of Guinea-Bissau has recently issued Marine Circular 11/2022 on Fuel Consumption Data and Recording – MARPOL Annex VI ([Marine Circular 11/2022 – 08/12/2022/ MEPC.328\(76\)](#)). The concrete Mar Cir has provided information and guidance to Shipowners and Managers operating G-B I.S.R. registered vessels, as well as to other interested parties, regarding the IMO Data Collection System for Fuel Oil consumption (DSC) in accordance with relevant MARPOL Annex VI Regulations, as amended. In addition, it provided instructions and guidance to companies operating G-B ISR vessels on fuel consumption data reporting, as required under Regulation 26. The G-B I.S.R. has authorized its existing Recognized Organizations to act as Reporting Organizations/Verifiers in order to collect, and verify fuel consumption data from G-B I.S.R. ships, and to report to IMO under the provisions of the applicable Regulation of MARPOL Annex VI.

2. IMO GISIS Module for Reporting of Fuel Oil Consumption Data

2.1 MEPC 70 (October 2016) adopted mandatory MARPOL Annex VI requirements for ships to record and report their fuel oil consumption. Under the amendments, ships of 5,000 GT and above will be required to collect fuel oil consumption data for each type of fuel oil they use, as well as, other specified data. The aggregated data will be reported to the flag State / authorized RO after the end of each calendar year and the flag State / authorized RO, having determined that the data have been reported in accordance with the requirements, will issue a Statement of Compliance to the ship.

2.2. ROs are required to subsequently transfer this data to an IMO GISIS Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Database. The GISIS module provides the IMO Ship Fuel Oil Consumption Database which allows Member States / authorized ROs to transfer ships' fuel oil consumption data and to download anonymized consumption records.

3. RO Authorization - GISIS Module: "Ship Fuel Oil Consumption".

3.1 Under the data collection system for fuel oil consumption of ships, as specified in MARPOL Annex VI, the G-B INTERNATIONAL Ships Registry has authorized ROs to submit data on behalf of the Administration, via the use of the GISIS Module: "Ship Fuel Oil Consumption". The authorized ROs may perform, inter alia, the following actions concerning the submission of data:

- submit the data for ships flying the Guinea-Bissau flag;
- designate a contact point responsible for communication with the IMO Secretariat if any technical matter arises concerning the submission of data; and
- have access to non-anonymized data submitted.

4. G-B International Ships Registry managing companies and ROs are kindly requested to take note of this information and be guided accordingly.
