**Subject: “Guinea-Bissau International Ships Registry (G-B I.S.R.) to Participate as Exhibitor at Posidonia 2026 Maritime Exhibition – Athens, Greece (1–5 June 2026)”**

Dear G-B I.S.R. Stakeholders, Partners & Maritime Industry Representatives,

The Guinea-Bissau International Ships Registry (G-B I.S.R.) is pleased to announce its official participation as exhibitor at the upcoming **Posidonia 2026 International Shipping Exhibition**, to be held in Athens, Greece, from **1 to 5 June 2026**, one of the world’s most prestigious and commercially influential maritime events. The participation of the G-B I.S.R. at Posidonia 2026 marks the Registry’s **second consecutive official exhibition presence**, following the successful participation during Posidonia 2024.

Posidonia has been established internationally as one of the leading global meeting points of the maritime industry, attracting shipowners, ship managers, classification societies, insurers, shipyards, maritime technology providers, financial institutions, Flag State authorities, and regulatory stakeholders from all major shipping jurisdictions. According to the official Posidonia statistics, the 2024 exhibition attracted more than 32,500 visitors, over 2,000 exhibitors, and participation from approximately 130–140 countries worldwide, confirming its status as one of the largest maritime exhibitions globally.

Within this framework, the G-B I.S.R. participation at Posidonia 2026 is strategically focused on the enhancement of direct commercial and institutional engagement with the Registry’s existing and prospective stakeholders, including:

- Shipowners and Ship Management Companies;
- P&I Clubs and Marine Insurance Providers;
- Recognized Organizations (ROs) and Classification Societies;
- Technical Verification and Compliance Service Providers;
- Maritime Consultants and Legal Advisors;
- Port State and Flag State Authorities;
- Maritime Technology and Digital Services Companies; and
- International maritime regulatory and operational stakeholders.

The participation of the G-B I.S.R. at Posidonia 2026 takes place **during a period of substantial institutional and commercial development for the Registry**. Since the commencement of its international operational expansion, the Registry has achieved significant fleet growth, expanded its international Deputy Registrars and representation network, strengthened cooperation with Recognized Organizations and maritime stakeholders, and enhanced its operational profile within the international maritime market. Current statistical indicators demonstrate continued fleet development both in terms of vessel numbers and aggregate gross tonnage, while the Registry continues to promote a modern and commercially responsive Flag Administration framework based on IMO compliance standards and operational efficiency.
